Minor in Intercultural Communication and Strategic Negotiation

In French language

The European Studies department offers to AUCA students an opportunity to obtain a minor degree in Intercultural Communication and Strategic Negotiation in French language. In order to start studying for minor in ES, a student must obtain permission from the chair of his/her department and the chair of ES department.

To apply for minor, students must have GPA 2.7 or higher. The level of French should be B1. The Certification by Alliance Française is preferable.

To earn the Minor degree in Intercultural Communication and Strategic Negotiation in French language, students must complete at least 42 credits including the Internship in FRN or ENG according to the Specialization. Thereby, 60% of course credits must be taken from the upper level courses. Only the courses with a grade "C-" or higher will be counted towards the fulfillment of minor requirements.
