

Major requirements

To receive a Bachelor of Arts degree in Law, a student must earn 144 cr/h in course work of which no fewer than 54 are derived from general education courses, plus 66 cr/h of courses required by the Law Department. Other 21 cr/h are the law electives courses and 3 cr/h are any elective course.
